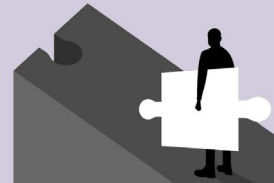


# It takes 17 years for evidence to reach clinical practice. Will you help us bridge the gap?



## About the research project

The University of Sydney is seeking expressions of interest from **staff responsible for quality improvement or service management in Australian alcohol or other drug services** to participate in an Expert Working Group. Group members will give feedback on the development of an implementation toolkit to facilitate the translation of the *Guidelines on co-occurring conditions (3rd edition)* into practice.
