

National Comorbidity Guidelines Train-the-Trainer Program: Frequently Asked Questions

I want to be a trainer! What do I need to do?

Great! To be a registered trainer of the Comorbidity Guidelines face-to-face program, you need to have completed the train-the-trainer workshop, either online or in person. To be eligible to enroll in a train-the-trainer workshop, you will need to have:

- Successfully completed tertiary training in a relevant field (and provide proof, if requested);
- Comprehensive knowledge of, and/or experience, working with people with co-occurring mental and substance use disorders;
- Skills in delivering interventions for people experiencing mental health and substance use;
- Sound training skills and the capacity to deliver workplace training.

Once you've completed the train-the-trainer workshop, you'll be asked to sign a Training Facilitator Agreement and you'll then be provided with access to training materials.

I can't attend a live training event - do you have online courses or is all your training conducted in person?

What's involved in the Training Facilitator Agreement?

All trainers who complete the train-the-trainer workshop will be asked to sign a Training Facilitator Agreement (Agreement) before being provided with the training materials. The Agreement sets out permissions and parameters as to how the training materials can (and cannot) be used. A copy of this agreement can be viewed here.

How can I be listed as a trainer on the Comorbidity website?

After completing the train-the-trainer workshop, you can choose to be included in our list of registered trainers on the training section of our website. Doing so will make it easier for those who are looking to receive training in their local service/area locate and contact registered trainers.

Trainers who are only providing training within their workplace can choose to not be included in our list.

How do I register a National Comorbidity Guidelines Face-to-Face Training Day?

You'll see in the Training Facilitator Agreement that you need to register all face-to-face training events and send through details of participants within seven days of the event. You can do this easily via <u>our training page</u>.

To make this easier, we recommend trainers specify a cut-off date for their face-to-face registration, after which trainers can upload their participant list via the Comorbidity Guidelines website.
